SHALL THE VOTERS OF THE PAINE MOUNTAIN SCHOOL DISTRICT APPROVE THE PAINE MOUNTAIN SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD TO EXPEND \$17,945,038 WHICH IS THE AMOUNT THE SCHOOL BOARD HAS DETERMINED TO BE NECESSARY FOR THE ENSUING FISCAL YEAR FOR THE PAINE MOUNTAIN SCHOOL DISTRICT? THIS REPRESENTS A 3.18% INCREASE FROM THE PREVIOUS YEAR. IT IS ESTIMATED THAT THIS PROPOSED BUDGET, IF APPROVED, WILL RESULT IN EDUCATION SPENDING OF \$15,564 PER EQUALIZED PUPIL. THE PROJECTED SPENDING PER EQUALIZED PUPIL IS 5.08% HIGHER THAN SPENDING FOR THE CURRENT YEAR.
