The Northfield Police Department is seeking a Level III, full-time, Vermont certified police officer to fill a current vacancy. This is a Union position with representation by the New England Police Benevolent Association (NEPBA). Officers work 12 hour shifts on a 2-2 3-2 2-3 shift schedule. Starting salary is based upon the step system, years of credible, FT, police service and current advance certifications and higher education.
