

2017 NORTHFIELD MUNICIPAL POOL RULES

- One person on the board
- One bounce
- No running
- Jump/dive off the board
- Advanced dives at lifeguard's discretion
- No swimming in diving well unless diving boards are not in use
- Swim to the nearest ladder to exit pool
- No foul language
- No food on the deck
- No playing with lifeguard equipment
- No hanging on ropes or lifting ropes
- One long whistle means exit the pool
- No smoking inside the park
- Only lifeguard-approved life vests can be used
- No toys in the water or on the pool deck
- Do not lift up the ropes
- Every child under the age of 16 must take a deep side test and be capable of passing level 6 in swimming. This is also at the discretion of the Pool Director
- No children can swim on the deep side without passing the test. However, during Family Swim, parents may take their children into deep water if they are with them in the water. Family Swim is from 5-7 p.m. only
- Children under 17 must be accompanied by a parent to swim after 5 p.m.
- You must be 18 years old to watch any child after 5:00 p.m.
- Summer Program kids must exit the pool by 4 p.m.
