- a. Flooding update
  - The foot path near the river is covered with gravel. It might need to be raked off of the path to allow mowing this summer.
  - The trees and shrubs in the park collected debris that might be damaging these plants.
     The damage might be exacerbated as snow builds up on the debris-packed plants.
  - 3. A substantial amount of new knotweed was deposited in the park. Another round of knotweed cleanup will be scheduled when the shoots emerge from the new knotweed material.

# b. Swing

- Donated funds will be used to purchase a new swing for the park. With input from the town manager, we decided that the swing and frame should be made of metal and the frame should be in-ground mounted. The frame will be black and the swing will be a hunter green to match existing benches in the park.
